Eligibility Requirements

1. Candidate must have completed, by date of this application, 50 hours of volunteer service at St. Luke's Cornwall Hospital.
2. Acceptance, by date of this application, to an accredited two or four-year College.
3. All parts of the application must be returned together.
4. ***Application materials must be submitted or post-marked by April 19, 2019.***

1. Documentation of commitment to volunteerism including 50 hours of volunteer service at St. Luke's Cornwall Hospital.
2. Essay, no more than 500 words, answering all questions.
3. Two (2) letters of recommendation. Letters may be submitted from your teacher(s), principal, clergy, employer(s), etc. **Letters from relatives are not accepted.**
4. Documentation of scholastic achievement of a Grade Point Average of 85 or higher.
5. Documentation of acceptance from an accredited two or four-year college.

Instructions

You must fully address all four sections in a clear and concise essay.

In essay form, please explain the following in 500 words or less:

- Why do you believe volunteerism and community service are important?
- What has your volunteer experience been like at St. Luke's Cornwall Hospital and how will that experience benefit you in the future?
- Why is receiving this scholarship important to you?
- What are your goals are for the future?

Please submit the following application materials by the deadline:

1. Your completed essay.
2. A signed letter from the either the SLCH Human Resource department or department representative which the volunteer hours were completed within. Letter must state the number of volunteer hours, and time frame which they were completed.
3. Two (2) letters of recommendation may be submitted from your teachers, principal, clergy, employers, etc. **Letters from relatives are not accepted.**
4. A copy of your transcripts reflecting an 85 or higher high school average.
5. A letter of acceptance from an accredited two or four-year college.
